While there are elements of similarity and common ground between the president's proposal and Republicans' goals, there remains a considerable way to go if business tax reform is to become a reality. Friday's conference call with Secretary Lew will provide you with an opportunity to hear the latest from the Administration, as well as register your thoughts on the topic.
